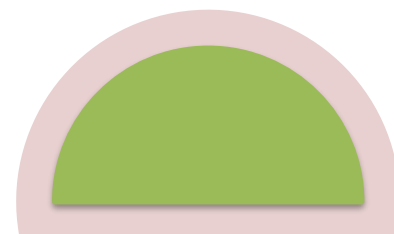

2. Can be the product affected by **sanctions**?

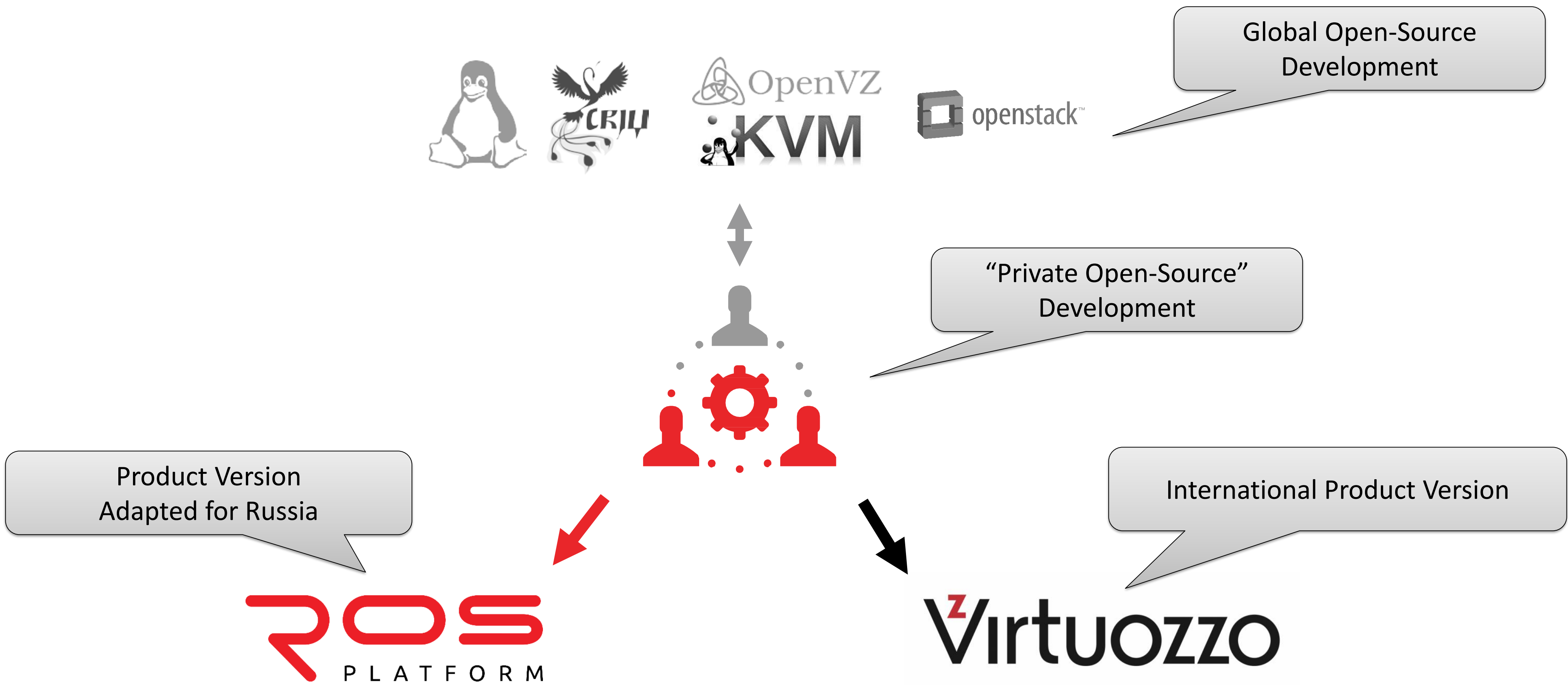
2. Technical/Organizational:
